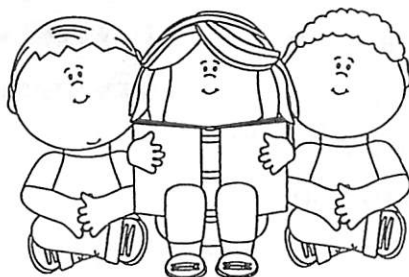


2. Read the book to or with your child.

*** This is a **REQUIRED** project for any student entering the second grade for the 2023-2024 school year.



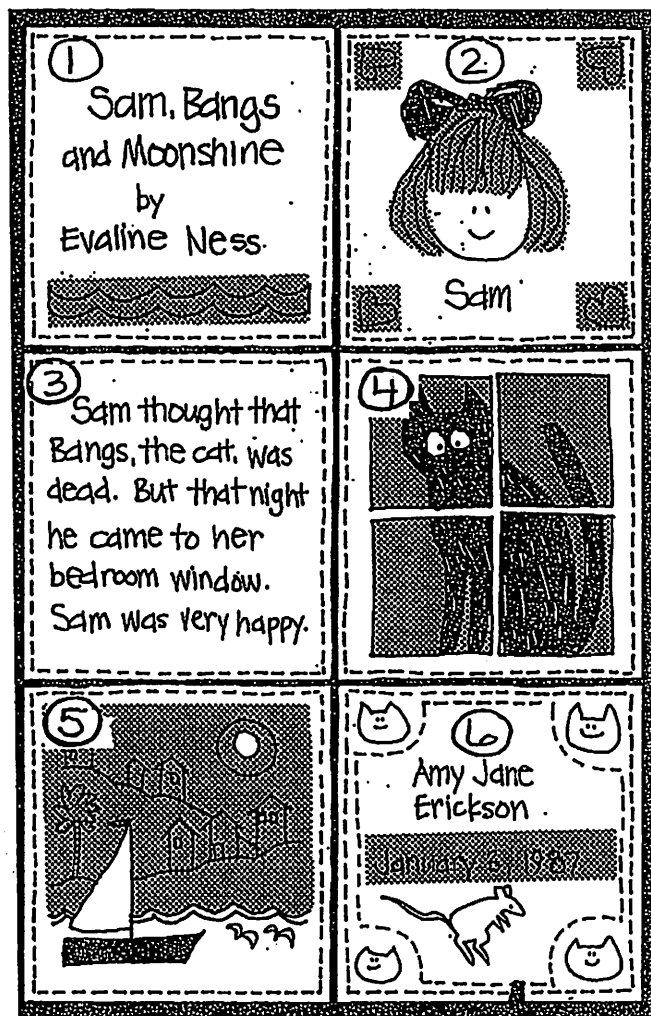
A Patchwork Pin-Up

What you need:

- One 18-inch-by-26-inch sheet of poster board or tagboard
- Six 8-inch-by-8-inch squares of white drawing paper
- A black, felt-tipped pen
- Crayons or markers in assorted colors
- Glue

What You Do:

1. Make six quilt patches by "stitching" around each piece of drawing paper with the black marking pen as shown.
2. Print the title of the book and the name of its author in the first quilt patch.
3. Draw a picture of the main character on the second quilt patch.
4. Write about your favorite part of the story on the third quilt patch.
5. Draw a picture of your favorite part of the story on the fourth quilt patch.
6. Draw a picture showing where the story took place on the fifth quilt patch.
7. Print your name and the date on the sixth quilt patch.
8. Turn these patches into a "quilt" by **gluing** them to the board as shown.
